

FROM THE INTERIM PRIEST

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St Mark's,

The past eight months have flown by since I joined this wonderful parish community at the beginning of November. My chief responsibility as Interim Priest is to keep the round of worship and pastoral ministrations going so that the Vestry and Search Committee can attend to the all-important work of calling a new priest.

During the first four months of 2024, I found myself doing many of the weekly office tasks, including preparing the weekly bulletin, after former Parish Administrator Sally North needed to resign for health reasons. This was useful experience as it helped me understand the parish's procedures and routines.

Then, at the beginning of May, we engaged Barbara Votolato in a one-year assignment as Interim Parish Administrator. She has been a Godsend—making it possible, among other things, to prepare, print, and mail this issue of *The Light* after a hiatus of many months.

As part of the "long return" from Covid, the Vestry and I worked together to reinstate the full Sunday morning schedule of services (at 8 am and 10 am) during the Winter / Spring of 2024, and to reestablish the Coffee Hour after the principal Sunday morning service.

In my remaining time at St Mark's, I plan to continue working with the Vestry on any outstanding issues that need to be addressed before a new Rector arrives. I treasure the opportunity to continue getting to know St Mark's parishioners. Do let me know if you have any pastoral needs – I am always eager to be of service!
