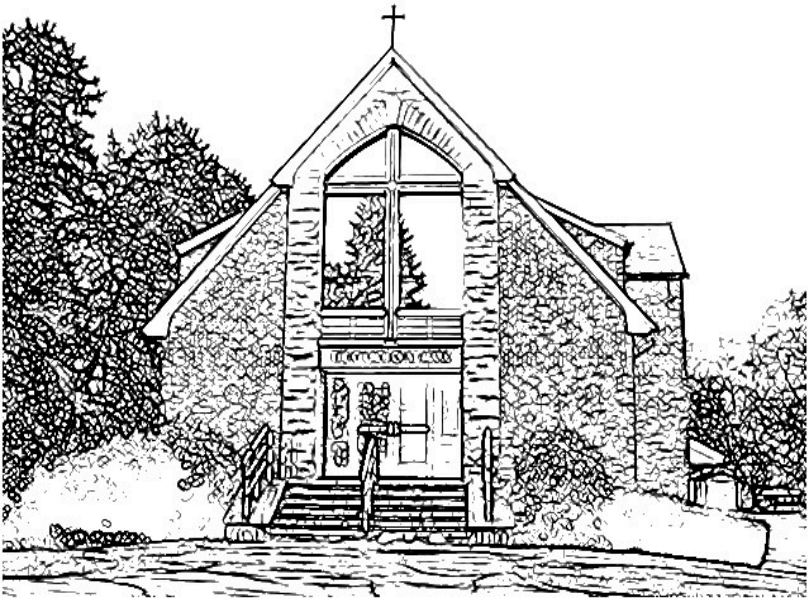

Alleluia the Lord is Risen Indeed!

While we venture into Eastertide some of us find ourselves in a world marked by anxiety, division, and uncertainty. I'm reminded that the resurrection of Jesus is not an escape from reality. It is God's declaration that love is stronger than death, that mercy outlasts violence, and that hope is not foolishness but faithful. Easter calls us to live differently and to forgive more freely, to give more generously, and to trust more deeply in the life God is bringing forth among us.

Eastertide is a time when we remember that death does not have the final word. We will venture through many stories of Christ's ministry to the world just before we reach his ascension on the day of Pentecost.

I pray that this season invites us to look for signs of resurrection in our own lives: in reconciled relationships, in renewed courage, in quiet acts of service, and in the steady rhythms of prayer and worship. And I, for one, believe that the risen Christ is present with us in Word, in Sacrament, and in the life we share as a parish community.

May these fifty days deepen your joy, strengthen your faith, and renew your confidence that Christ is alive and at work in you. We hope you will join us for worship and the social events that we have upcoming.

The vestry and I are looking toward an in-house vestry retreat this summer as we think, pray and discuss deepening our reach and ministry in and to the Warwick community. I hope to have more to share here with you in the next newsletter.
